<h3>History of North Augusta</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Three towns formerly stood where North Augusta now stands before the booming cotton economy put the City on the map.• North Augusta was originally founded as a residential and resort town, after luxurious Hampton Terrace Hotel brought in visitors from all over the country.• North Augusta was considered as the site for Hollywood before it was moved to California.	<h3>Doing Business With North Augusta</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• There are approximately 70 manufacturing firms in Aiken County with over 24,000 workers. Manufactured products include glass fibers, cotton, yarn, concrete, steel, paper, bread, and many others.• Was voted as one of the Best Places for Millennial Job Seekers in 2015.• North Augusta is located between Augusta, GA and Aiken, SC, bringing all the advantages of big city living to a charming small town.
<h3>Residents of North Augusta</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• North Augusta has 21,348 residents that is located on the north bank of the Savannah River.• The Riverview Park Activities Center is also located along the Savannah River.• North Augusta has many historic homes, including the Rosemary Inn and Lookaway Hall. There are a number of other included on the National Register of Historic Places.• North Augusta residents enjoy low water and sewer rates, great schools and low crime rates.	<h3>The North Augusta Greenway</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The North Augusta Greenway was named after the former North Augusta Mayor, Thomas W. Greene.• The Greenway is 12.5 miles of beautiful, paved recreational trail ways that follow an abandoned railroad and overlook the Savannah River.• The Greenway is a scenic trail along the Savannah River and meanders throughout the city and many of its neighborhoods for easy access.• The Greenway is often called “the jewel of the city”.

North Augusta has 6 City Council Members in addition to Mayor Lark Jones: James Adams, J. Robert Brooks, Pat Carpenter, Kenneth McDowell, Fletcher Dickert, and David McGhee.
